### PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

- Installation of a hand sanitizing station at the main entrance. Greeters/Ushers are instructing individuals who enter to use the station.
- Installation of additional hand sanitizing stations throughout the building.
- Signs posted in the restrooms "Please Wash Your Hands"
- Waving during "Meet and Greet" instead of shaking hands.
- Encouraging individuals who are not feeling well to remain at home.
- Committee Chairs are invited to hold meetings telephonically. Please contact Norma to set up a Conference Call number. This will be her only task related to Committee/Ministry Meetings. It is the responsibility of the Chair or Committee/Ministry Secretary to contact members with the call in number and code.
